Tuesday, May 26, 2020 / 6 p.m. Minutes

**PRESENT:** Reva Laituri (President), Scott Jandron (Vice-President), Amber Talo (Treasurer), Lynn Andronis (Secretary), Chris Danik, Leslie Hurst, Austin Loehr, Alex Petrin, Brett Specker, Colleen Whitehead.

**ABSENT:** None

**GUESTS:** None (meeting was held via Zoom)

- 1. Call to Order/Attendance: Meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m.
- 2. Public Comment: None.
- 3. <u>Approval of Agenda</u>: Chris made a motion, seconded by Scott, to approve to Agenda as presented. Motion passed with unanimous consent.
- 4. <u>Mission Moment</u>: Amber shared "before and after" photos of the first horse that was housed in the barn, spanning a 5-month period. Between our facility and volunteers from Sally's Fund, we were able to offer transitional care until the horse was transferred. Suggestion was made to include a follow-up in our newsletter.

## 5. Approval of Minutes:

a. <u>April 27, 2020 Regular Meeting</u> – *Colleen made a motion, seconded by Austin, to approve to Minutes as presented. Motion passed with unanimous consent.* 

### 6. Unfinished Business:

- a. <u>Construction update</u> Amber reported that Superior Polymer was at shelter last week to begin the process of repairing the flooring and Alex added that they were there today and that they will be there tonight and tomorrow. Alex will try to do walk through for any potential follow-up. Swick will be scheduled (by Hall) for any punch list items. Alex has not received any updates regarding punch list items. Keith (from Hall) will be contacting Alex to coordinate staff scheduling. Amber reported to Hall the uneven gravel surrounding the water spigots in Paws Park. They came out Friday morning with small stones for the areas.
- b. Annual Report/Meeting The question was raised as to whether or not we are having an Annual Meeting and an Annual Report after the audit is completed. (The completion date for the audit is uncertain due to COVID.) What are our future plans? Per our Bylaws, the Annual Meeting shall be conducted on the second Tuesday in June. Among the items to be discussed at that meeting is a presentation of the Annual Report. Some members lobbied for holding off on preparing the Annual Report so that we could use audited financial statements as opposed to unaudited statements. Others lobbied for using unaudited financial statements for the Annual Report so as to complete it sooner. Instead of tying the two subjects together (Annual Meeting and Annual Report), there was discussion for treating them as separate issues. Alex made a motion, seconded by Lynn, to cancel the Annual Meeting this year. Motion passed with unanimous consent. The Annual Report still needs to be compiled though and someone needs to pull the information together. Colleen has offered to take the lead on writing the report with board member input; Lynn offered to complete the stats portion; we have yearend 2019 (unaudited) financial statement.

c. <u>Update on E.D. Search</u> – Alex reported that he has received some emails from Mr. Crumm who reported that they were having a slow start, with not many candidates. A recent email from him reported that he has received 10 new applications over the past week and will set up interviews with them. Said he was going to open it up to get more people and wondered if salary or benefits might be hindering interest and asked if there was any flexibility on our part. The final payment for his services is payable on the hiring of a candidate. Austin asked if there was a time length imposed for certain capabilities (i.e., 3 years of fundraising). Answer was "yes". Alex will be in touch with Mr. Crumm this week.

## 7. New Business:

- a. Recommendation from the Finance Committee RE: PPP Loan Application Finance Committee has been researching PPP loans. As 75% of the loan must go to payroll expense, Amber believes it would be beneficial for our revenue operating budget. Although we fill out the application, the dollar amount is calculated by the agency not us. They then inform us if we qualify. In addition, there is no penalty for not using the awarded money. Austin made a motion, seconded by Alex, to approve the recommendation from Finance Committee to begin the process to apply for the PPP loan through MBank. Motion passed with unanimous consent.
- b. Temporary Impound Agreement with Ishpeming City Law Enforcement staff from Ishpeming Township contacted the shelter. The door at their shelter was broken and they wanted to bring a dog to us for the hold period. Reva contacted the Chief and then sent a draft agreement to them to temporarily use our services. The agreement was on a month-to-month basis with a 10-day notification for cancellation. Reva placed the document on the drive late today. Amber made a motion, seconded by Leslie, to authorize Reva to sign a temporary impound agreement with Ishpeming Township. Motion passed with unanimous consent.
- 8. Communications: None.
- 9. President's Report: Report submitted.
- 10. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Individual monthly reports submitted. Amber reported that the recent solicitation letter has done really well.
  - a. <u>January Financial Reports</u> Lynn made a motion, seconded by Scott, to approve the reports as presented. Motion passed with unanimous consent.
  - b. <u>February Financial Reports</u> *Austin made a motion, seconded by Colleen, to approve the reports as presented. Motion passed with unanimous consent.*
  - c. <u>March Financial Reports</u> Chris made a motion, seconded by Alex, to approve the reports as presented. Motion passed with unanimous consent.
  - d. <u>April Financial Reports</u> Brett made a motion, seconded by Austin, to approve the reports as presented. Motion passed with unanimous consent.

Colleen asked if Amber has more info on Thrivent and Simple Plan. The bookkeeper will look into making the payments as we are not paid up to date. Per Amber, this will be handled this week. Brett is investigating another firm and will update.

## 11. Shelter Operations Reports:

- a. Community Relations/Volunteer Coordinator Report Written report from Ann submitted.
- b. <u>Stats</u> Year-to-date data (as of the end of April) posted. Lynn pointed out that the length-of-stay for both dogs and cats have increased since the beginning of the year from single digits to double digits. She also noted that the total number of year-to-date intakes over the last few years has been declining from 250 (2020) to 394 (2019) to 353 (2018) to 419 (2017). We have early information that there is a case in Houghton that may come to us. It is not clear,

but we do know that they are working on keeping the horses where they are instead of coming to us.

- c. Operational Updates Related to Covid-19 Reva is getting updates from staff. With things starting to open up a bit, the shelter may start having more activity and we need to plan for possible increased traffic and adjust to novel situations. Kitten season may be starting; Paws Park is open now; staff wants to do cat transfers; staff vacancies are hard to fill now; the length-of-stay for animals would increase due to the current requirement of scheduling appoints for adopters. Colleen also reported that some grant applications require a demonstration of negative financial impact. On another note, Colleen asked about our response plan and transition from now to "normal". Reva reported that she has worked on it and sent a draft to Ann and Supervisors for their review. It is still in the process of being reviewed by staff. Reva will send it to Colleen afterwards for her review.
- d. Other Operational Reports Leslie asked where kitty litter is coming from since she is not picking up on the weekly Super One order. It is due to our low census and people ordering it for us via Amazon.

The temporary impound agreement with the City of Ishpeming was signed. The door that was broken at the Ishpeming Township Pound apparently has been temporarily fixed, but we have not yet received a termination notification from the City of Ishpeming. Since the agreement was month-to-month, we are still accepting any animals they might bring to us.

Ishpeming Township has sent two people to us with stray animals. After the second, I called the police chief to advise him we would be more than happy to impound the township's animals, however, we would need to enter into a contract for those services. He said he would look into other options but they did not have the capability to provide care for animals that could potentially be sick. In the second case, he opted to return the cat to the person who found it, telling them he couldn't bring it to us. The people who found the cat then brought it to us.
